The Purpose for a Church Orchestra

The primary purpose of a church orchestra is to enhance congregational singing.

The church orchestra will also:

- provide an opportunity for many instrumentalists to praise and worship the Lord with the sound of instruments as commanded in Psalm 150.
- be a good place for young people to develop a life style of Christian service.

 For some it may be the first place were they will serve instead of being served.
- enhance the accompaniment group for choir specials.
- be able to provide special music for the following:
 - a. Worship service b. Offertory c. Prelude d. Outreach locations

Advantages of Using Simple Orchestrations

- Simple orchestrations will demand minimal rehearsal time.
- Simple orchestrations allow the players to concentrate on the text of the hymn.
- Simple orchestrations function as the foundational material for an accompaniment group.
- Simple orchestrations would allow a mix and match instrumentation.
- Simple orchestrations give a single player the ability to participate in a song service.
- Simple orchestrations allow inexperienced players to grow into experienced players.
- Simple orchestrations will allow more players to participate in the accompaniment group.
- Simple orchestrations allow the melody to be the prominent voice.
- Simple orchestrations help keep players from radically deviating from the harmonies used by the keyboards and part-singers in the congregation.

Orchestrations Provide Material for Personal Growth


- The book may be used as part of the praise section for personal devotions.
- An orchestration book will provide a wealth of sight-reading material.
- A student may play a couple of hymns to relax after an arduous study period.
- Players could develop their own arrangements from the transposed orchestrations.

Benefits of Using Orchestrations from Stockton Music Services

- A single line of music per staff reduces the confusion from decoding.
- Two lines per system is a common practice in duet and method books.
- Plenty of white space makes the music easier to read.
- Page turns during a song are avoided.
